





CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: NM 68-US 64 Roadway Project – Paseo Del Pueblo in Taos Scheduled to Resume Construction Monday, April 12, 2021

Update as of Friday, April 9, 2021


Construction on the NM 68-US 64 Roadway Project on Paseo del Pueblo in Taos will resume Monday, April 12, 2021.

Crews will be wrapping up Phase 1 work and starting Phase 2. Regular work hours will be 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday-Friday, although crews may work longer hours or on weekends as needed.

Traffic Impacts: Paseo
Del Pueblo Sur will be
reduced to one lane in
each direction (north and
south) from the La Posta
Rd/Cervantes St
intersection to the Siler
Rd/Los Pandos Rd
intersection.

Motorists traveling through this area should expect delays and obey the 25 miles per hour speed limit.

Additional construction phases will follow, and the project is expected to be completed in late 2022.



About the project: This project is designed to correct physical and geometric deficiencies, reduce congestion, and add new ADA ramps and sidewalks for pedestrian access to improve safety and mobility along the NM 68/US 64 highway, also known as Paseo Del Pueblo.
