





CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Crews to Rebuild Northeast Quadrant of Tewa St/Albright St Intersection Week of Oct 4-8, 2021; Work Continuing on Phase 2-B of NM 68-US 64 Project

NOTE: All construction is weather permitting and subject to change without notice.


Update as of Thursday, September 30, 2021

From Monday, Oct 4, through Friday, Oct 8, 2021


Crews will rebuild the northeast and southeast quadrants of the Tewa St/Albright St intersection. Westbound traffic will be detoured west on Albright St, then north on Los Pandos to the intersection of Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Siler Rd/Los Pandos Rd. Crews will rebuild the northeast quadrant first, then the southeast quadrant. Access will be maintained to all businesses (see detour map at right).

Ongoing: Construction is in Phase 2-B

(See detour map at left) Lasting through early November 2021,



traffic is shifted to the west on Paseo del Pueblo Sur between the Tewa/Albright intersection and the Siler/Los Pandos intersection. One lane of traffic will remain open in each direction (north and south).



Traffic is shifted to the outside lanes on Paseo del Pueblo Sur from the Siler/Los Pandos intersection to the Ojitos intersection.

Also continuing:

The <u>northern</u> driveways for Ace Hardware, Big 5 Sporting Goods and Smith's Food & Drug are CLOSED, along with the <u>southern</u> driveway for Hinds & Hinds/U-Haul, so crews can extend a concrete box culvert. This work is expected to last through mid to late October. Access to all of these businesses will be maintained through alternate driveways.

Regular work hours are <u>7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday-Friday</u>, although crews may work longer hours or on weekends as needed.

Motorists traveling through this area should expect delays and obey the 25-miles-per-hour speed limit.
