





CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Flaggers to Direct Traffic at Paseo Del Pueblo Sur and Intersection of Camino de la Placita/Quesnel Weds, May 10-Fri, May 12 So Crews Can Install Temporary Traffic Signal at Intersection

NOTE: All construction is weather permitting and subject to change without notice.

Update as of Tuesday, May 9, 2023

NEW: From Wednesday, May 10 through Friday, May 12, flaggers will direct traffic at the intersection of Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Camino de la Placita/Quesnel so crews can install a temporary traffic signal. *Motorists traveling in this area should expect delays and use extra caution.*

The following ongoing traffic impacts will remain in place:

- Ojitos Road is closed at Paseo del Pueblo Sur. Northbound motorists can use Salazar Rd to Siler Rd to Hatchery Rd as a detour to access Ojitos Rd. Southbound motorists can use Camino de la Placita to Comanche Rd as a detour to access Ojitos Rd.
- Siler Road is closed at Paseo del Pueblo Sur. Traffic can use La Posta Rd to Salazar Rd to Siler Rd as a detour.
- Traffic on Paseo del Pueblo Sur is shifted to the east between Siler/ Los Pandos and Tewa/Albright, with one lane open in each direction (northbound and southbound).

The speed limit is reduced to 25 mph in the construction zone. Motorists traveling in this area are encouraged to use extra caution and give themselves extra time to reach their destinations. Ranchitos Rd

After completing work on Paseo del

Pueblo Sur between Tewa/Albright and Siler/Los Pandos, crews will work on Paseo del Pueblo Sur between Siler/Los Pandos and Quesnel through fall. If there is time before crews go into winter suspension, they will begin work on Phase 3 on Paseo del Pueblo Norte from Quesnel to north of Civic Plaza Drive.
