

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Crews Continuing Work on Paseo Del Pueblo Sur and Paseo Del Pueblo Norte with Goal of Completing Project in Spring 2025 (Weather Permitting)

NOTE: All construction is weather permitting and subject to change without notice.

Update as of Wednesday, February 19, 2025

Crews have been working throughout the fall and winter on this project with the goal of completing it in spring 2025, weather permitting. Here is the status as of mid-February 2025:

Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Quesnel

Intersection: Everything is complete except for installation of the new traffic signal and paving. The sidewalk should be completed in late February. Paving will occur when daytime temperatures reach 50 degrees Fahrenheit or higher for an extended period of time.

Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Kit Carson

Intersection: Everything is complete except for paving. Paving will occur when daytime temperatures reach 50 degrees Fahrenheit or higher for an extended period of time.

Paseo del Pueblo Norte north of Quesnel:

Crews are working on the east side in the northbound lane. On this side of the project, all curb and gutter and about 80 percent of the sidewalk is completed.

Asphalt paving will take place when the sidewalk is completed, all traffic signals are installed and daytime temperatures reach 50 degrees Fahrenheit or higher for an extended period of time.

The detour for northbound traffic is Camino de la Placita.

Paseo del Pueblo Norte and Civic Plaza Drive Intersection: Everything is complete except for installation of traffic signals and a small section of sidewalk. The sidewalk should be completed by the end of February, with additional electrical work required before traffic signals can be installed.

Paseo del Pueblo Norte and Montecito Intersection: Everything is complete except for installation of traffic signals and a small section of sidewalk. The sidewalk should be completed by the end of February, with additional electrical work required before traffic signals can be installed.

Regular hours are **Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5:30 p.m.** although the crew may work longer hours or on weekends as needed.
